

# Information sheet membership application form

## Federatie Veilig Nederland

---

### **A. Federatie Veilig Nederland**

As stated in regulations membership of Federatie Veilig Nederland is restricted to:

- **Regular members:** natural persons, legal entities or non-legal entities established in or outside the Netherlands that must be designated as manufacturers, assembly companies, official importers, dealers, security installers or distributors or service providers within the field of security and/or (fire)safety.
- **Associate members:** natural persons, legal entities or companies with non-legal personality established in or outside the Netherlands, who work in the field of security and/or (fire)safety, but who are not eligible for regular membership on account of their business. Associate members, have no voting rights
- **Prospective members:** natural persons, legal entities or companies with non-legal personality established in or outside the Netherlands that meet all the requirements for a regular membership, but do not (yet) have the necessary approvals or certificates. The prospective membership is possible for a maximum of two years. If prospective members do not meet all the requirements for regular membership, the prospective membership will be canceled. Prospective members have no voting rights.

#### De Federatie Veilig Nederland aims to:

Representing the general, economic, commercial and strategic interests of members in the field of security and (fire)safety. The Federatie Veilig Nederland wants to expand brand awareness and to further profile itself as "the Dutch association of entrepreneurs for all security issues". The Federatie Veilig Nederland is not set out to make profits.

#### General Assembly and General Board

Every year two assembly's of members are organized. The general board of the Federatie Veilig Nederland consists of at least five members. A winter meeting in January and a summer meeting in June. The general board of the Federation consists of at least five members

### **B. DEPARTMENTS, MARKETS AND THEME GROUPS**

Membership is intended for companies active in one or both fields of the Federatie Veilig Nederland:

- Fire safety
- Security

Additional criteria may apply to membership in one or more markets / sections (page 4). The relevant section and/or the general board of Federatie Veilig Nederland rules about admission to the section and/or theme groups.

## Contribution 2019\*

### Two kinds of membership

#### **Basic membership**

Membership is available from € 1.025 a year for a basic membership of one section. Participation in multiple sections is possible. An additional membership per section is € 1.025.

Membership benefits included, such as up-to-date information on industry developments, access to a broad network, advocacy and various discounts including training.

Each member owes a one-time entrance fee upon joining. This entry fee has been set at € 225 for 2019.

Basic membership is open to regular and/or associate members referred to in the regulation of the association, being natural persons, legal entities or non-legal entities established in or outside the Netherlands that meet all the requirements for regular membership, but opt for a limited form of membership.

This form of membership is intended for companies that, for example, do not want to participate in the entire meeting circuits of the Federation or do not (yet) meet the statutory conditions. These companies do wish to be informed however of developments within the association.

The basic membership offers:

- Access to 2 annual general assembly's
- General information
- Information from the section
- Use of Federatie label
- Network meetings
- Promotion of safety and technology applications with partners
- Lobby
- Promotion in general
- Financial member benefits
- Market information
- Member services

#### **Premium membership**

A premium membership offers additional benefits to the basic membership, such as voting rights, access to section meetings and actively determining the course of Federatie Veilig Nederland by taking part in one of the working groups and/or theme groups.

The premium membership is available from € 3,430 a year at a maximum of 50 FTE.

The membership fees of Federatie Veilig Nederland have been set for 2019 at:

- € 3,430 a year for a maximum of 50 employees (FTE)
- € 4,185 a year for a maximum of 100 employees (FTE)
- € 4,940 a year for more than 100 employees (FTE).

These fees includes membership of one section.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Due to the specific expenses of the section Sprinklertechniek, an extra project budget is charged for members of that section.

Membership in multiple fields/sections is possible. An additional fee per discipline/section of € 1,510 a year will be charged. The one-time entrance fee is € 450.

The premium membership is open to regular members mentioned in the regulation of the association, being natural persons, legal entities or non-legal entities established in or outside the Netherlands companies designated as manufacturers, assembly companies, official importers, dealers, distributor, installer or service provider in the field of security and/or (fire)safety who also meets the specific requirements referred to in article 5 paragraph 2 of the regulation of the association.

The premium membership offers:

- All the benefits of a basic membership, plus extra benefits such as:
- Access to all (section) meetings, where affiliated
- Participate in theme and working groups, committees and think tanks (co-decide)
- Voting rights

## Federatie Veilig Nederland: departments, markets and sections

Federatie Veilig Nederland is the representative association for technical (fire)safety in the Netherlands. An association that binds members and also an association that contributes to the connection of the industry with society.

### Firesafety

#### Market Structural

\* **Section Smoke Control Systems**

Not the fire itself, but smoke and heat are the greatest dangers for humans and animals in the event of a fire. Members offer a controlled fire ventilation systems and with result.

#### Market Prevention

\* **Section Fire detection & components / evacuation alarm systems**

Active where the safety of people and the continuity of society matters. The high quality is underlined by reaching the level of "Recognized Fire Detection Company". A section with the aim of delivering quality products that add value to the functioning of fire safety installations.

\* **Section Smoke and carbon monoxide detectors**

All leading producers and suppliers of smoke detectors in the Netherlands are gathered in this section. They aim to work from a joint point of view, with objective information and where possible together with governments, towards higher fire safety for both the consumer and the professional market.

\* **Section Emergency Lighting**

The emergency lighting section primarily focuses on the delivery, service and maintenance of emergency lighting systems in order to increase the safety of a building.

## Market Repression

- \* **Section Fire Extinguishers**  
Represents a group that can be described as small but effective. The members of this section provide every conceivable product, service and maintenance in the field of small fire extinguishers.
- \* **Section Automatic extinguishing systems**  
Specialized in supplying and installing automatic extinguishing systems that must function in a complex environment.
- \* **Section Sprinkler systems**  
Represents the installers of sprinkler systems. The members of this section supply sprinkler systems that ensure a fire-safe working and living environment and that are expertly designed, installed and maintained.

## Security

### Market Signaling

- \* **Section Burglar and Robbery components**  
Members who are involved in the development, production, delivery and support of high-quality alarm systems.
- \* **Section Electric Access Control**  
The companies are concerned with access control which is required in many situations. Buildings, recreational objects and parking facilities are just a few examples.
- \* **Section Video specialists (CCTV)**  
The members are specialized in all relevant aspects: from advice to delivery and maintenance of camera observation systems. The concepts: observation, recognition and identification are familiar territory.

### Market Systems

- \* **Vakgebied Construction site security**  
These members make an important contribution to reducing crime (theft, burglary and destruction) at construction sites and are working on a qualification system for the Construction Site Security Covenant.
- \* **Vakgebied Solutions**  
These members are involved in consultancy, design, construction and after-sales service for complicated, non-everyday security applications.

### Market Surveillance

- \* **Section Monitoring Alarm Receiving Centres (MARC's)**  
The affiliated companies offer services such as "emergency center service" and "remote monitoring" and are available 24 hours a day.
- \* **Section Safety supervision**  
The members create safety at work, provide expertise and provide fire guards on the spot, but also think and work from a broader perspective in solutions/concepts.
